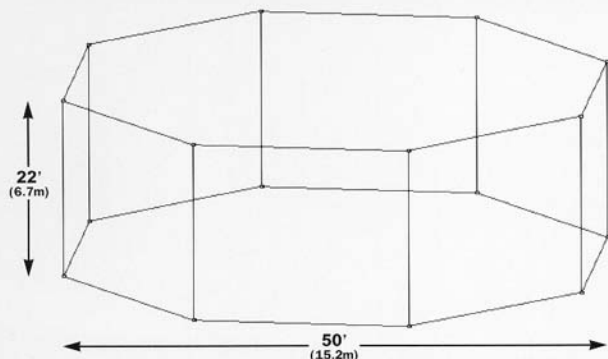

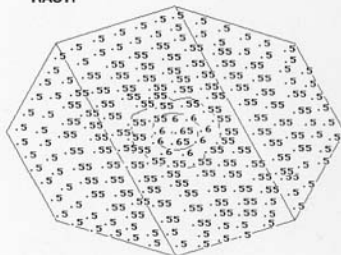

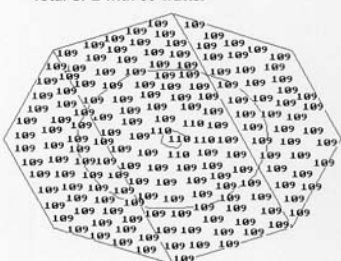

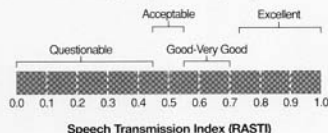
Total SPL with 50 watts.



Decibels

- 120 - jet takeoff 200' away
- 110 - loud rock music
- 100 - heavy truck close by
- 90 - 5,000 shouting people in an arena
- 80 - boiler room
- 70 - heavy traffic
- 60 - vacuum cleaner 10' away
- 50 - normal conversation
- 40 - large store

Quality of Speech Intelligibility



Typical Sound Pressure Levels (A-weighted)

Speech Transmission Index (RASTI)

- A single speaker can cover a large area with full frequency music and intelligible voice. A distributed system requires far fewer speakers than a conventional speaker system.
- No hot spots; no dead spots.
- Speakers can be supplied in any color.
- Speakers can be moved easily if exhibits change or museum expands, etc.
